Dear Sir/Madam:

Fort Worth Scottish Rite Foundation, Inc. annually awards scholarships to graduating seniors of high schools and other secondary schools in its thirty-three county service area. This program has been in existence for over forty years and has cumulatively awarded over 1.6 million dollars to deserving graduates.

No fewer than fifty (50) scholarships for \$1,500 each will be granted in 2022. Five (5) of these are reserved for students who will be attending a community college. Only one scholarship to a student at any one school will be awarded.

Application packages must be prepared strictly in accordance with the instructions and must be postmarked or hand delivered to the Fort Worth Scottish Rite office on or before Friday, February 25, 2022. Qualifying applications are reviewed and independently scored by multiple members of our Scholarship Committee. The applications are then ranked by their cumulative score, with scholarships awarded to the highest scorers subject to the five (5) reserved for community college attendees and the one scholarship per school restriction.

Approximately mid-May 2022 all applicants will be notified by mail whether or not they have been awarded a scholarship. At that time the awardees will also be invited to attend our Grand Annual Banquet, scheduled for June 11, 2022.
